- ♪ *Sundays throughout the year from September - June; special concerts and Liturgical Feast Days.*

- ♪ *A choir rehearsal is an energizing experience (somewhat like an exercise class) Through weekly rehearsals, members improve their musical skills - voice training, diction, dynamics and other musical nuances necessary for artistic choral singing;*
