Purpose: To Bring Holy Communion to the Homebound
and to Assist in Distributing the Body and Blood of Christ at Mass

Responsibilities:

- ☒ Be a role model of reverence for our Lord's sacramental presence in Holy Communion
- ☒ Commit to bringing Holy Communion to at least one homebound person on a regular basis, at a mutually convenient time
- ☒ Agree to serve at a minimum of two Masses per month
- ☒ Attend regularly scheduled meetings - usually two a year
- ☒ Be willing to cover for your fellow Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion when asked, if at all possible
- ☒ Be available to serve at Holy Day Masses

Gifts - Qualifications - Skills Needed:

- ☒ Profound reverence for our Lord's Body and Blood
- ☒ Deep spiritual commitment to the sacramental life of the Church
- ☒ Comfortable praying with the homebound (We provide you with a booklet of prayers)
- ☒ Comfortable standing up in front of others during Mass



Amount of Time Required: To bring Holy Communion to the Homebound usually takes about 45 minutes, but can vary depending on the situation and how much time you spend with the person. To distribute Communion during Mass there is no extra time needed other than the time you spend at Mass

Length of Commitment: No set length of service

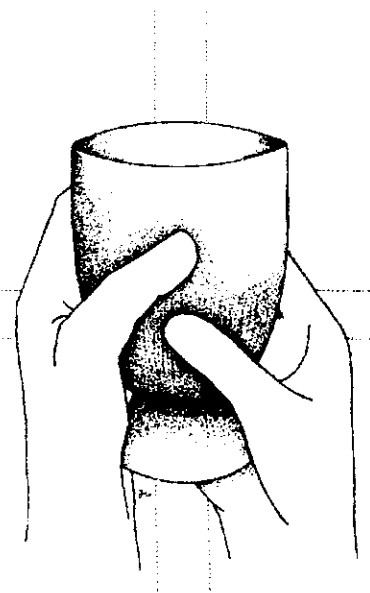
