

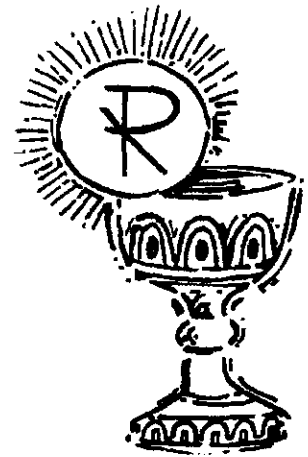
NOCTURNAL ADORATION

This time is a combination of communal and individual prayer.

AMOUNT OF TIME REQUIRED: One hour a month

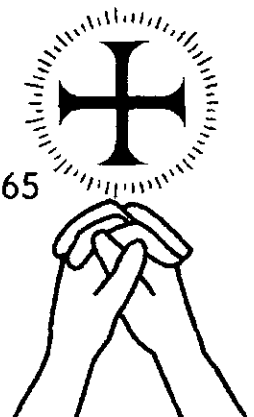
WHEN MINISTRY IS PERFORMED: Every First Friday of the month from 8:00pm - 9:00pm
